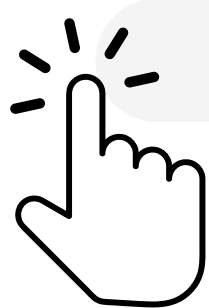

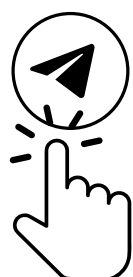

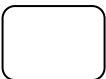

**Part Four: Supplementary Readers: (8 marks)**

**Notes:**

The supplementary reader's syllabus has been reintroduced since the academic year 2010, due to the ministerial mandate NO. 1 dated (24th, January 2010) and with reference to mandate issued by the director general of the National Center for Curriculum and Educational Research NO.(20) dated 4th, July, 2010.

The supplementary readers are compulsory, starting from the academic year (2018 - 2019) onwards, due to the directives of the Minister of Federal Education and the mandate issued by the secretary general of ministry of education NO. 1 /48 / ك و ت ث , dated 10/2018/4/. Therefore, all the states, all over the country schools, at both secondary and basic stages, are recommended to teach the required supplementary readers textbooks, commencing from grade five basic level up to the third year secondary, in order to upraise and promote the students standard in English language.

The supplementary readers' questions are considered as part of the English language exam paper or complementary tasks intend to develop and consolidate the English language standard in general education in Sudan. They are granted 25 percent out of the total scores of the basic level certificate exam paper and the secondary certificate.

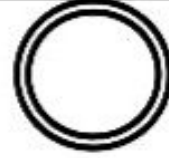

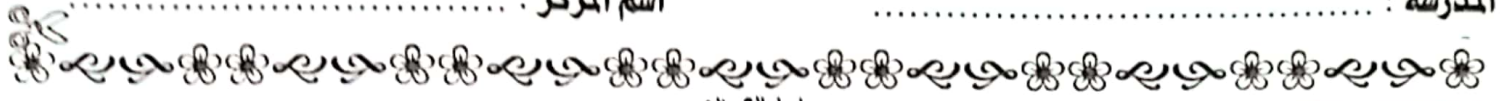

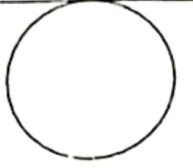
